Could this be you?

Community land trusts are democratic, non-profit organisations that own and develop land for the benefit of the community.

They are community organisations run by ordinary people who want to make a difference to their local community, putting control of assets into the hands of local people. They ensure that the homes are permanently and genuinely affordable. CLTs act as long-term stewards of land and the assets on it.
