Beacon Road, Ditchling Surface Dressing

We'll soon be working between the junctions of the B2112 and Underhill Lane to improve the condition of the road.

A layer of bitumen is sprayed onto the road to seal it and stone chippings are then spread on top. The road surface is then rolled to embed the chippings.

Monday 23 June: Removal of cat's eyes 7pm-7am

Sunday 29 June: Surface Dressing treatment 7pm-7am

If needed, lining, cats eyes and HFS will be replaced at a later date which will be confirmed via advanced warning signs.

During the above times, access will be restricted to residents only. Should you need access, please speak with the team onsite who will assist you.
