



Ditchling Community Resilience: Be Prepared

Ditchling Parish Council and the **Sussex Resilience Forum** endorse the Government's **Prepare Campaign**:



- Call 999 if you or someone else are in immediate danger
- Be informed about risks in our local area (eg surface water floods, power cuts, water cuts, sewage spills)
- Sign up for alerts and warnings and help others to do this
- Learn basic first aid (there are free online courses)
- Sign up for the **Priority Services Register** if eligible, or help your family and neighbours to do so
- Make a plan for emergencies affecting your home (template available on the **Prepare Campaign** website)
- Prepare your home (safety, insurance, heat, cold, storms etc)
- Store emergency supplies (torch, batteries, **water**, tinned food, medicines, baby supplies etc)
- Support those without internet access to access the fuller advice on the **Prepare Campaign** website
- Share emergency information on social media and by 'phone but be prepared for situations with no internet
- Be prepared to support neighbours who may need help in an emergency

If **Ditchling Parish Council** receives information about a major emergency it will

- Share information on its website and village social media
- Post information on noticeboards and signs if necessary
- Coordinate with local authorities and emergency services
